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In the aftermath of *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization* in 2022, New York became one of eight states that On March 4, CMS's Center for Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Plan (CHIP) Services announced its [rescission of two Center Informational Bulletins \(CIBs\)](#) that described opportunities available under Medicaid/CHIP to cover certain services that address health-related social needs (HRSN). CMS states that the rescission is necessary while it evaluates policy options consistent with Medicaid/CHIP program requirements and objectives.
